

CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS: ONLINE GALLERY

Attention Expressive Arts Therapy Students:

We are offering continuing expressive arts therapy concentration and certificate students the opportunity to send one submission of work to be considered for publication in the online expressive arts therapy student artwork gallery, which is hosted on the ASU expressive arts website. The submitted work must have been created by you as part of an academic course requirement since you have been enrolled in the program. The expressive arts therapy program coordinator has the right to deny online publication of any material that is deemed inappropriate for web publication. However, it is our goal that every continuing student is represented in the gallery project who expresses the desire to participate.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- You are currently enrolled in or have completed at least one expressive arts therapy course.
- The submitted work was completed as a program course requirement since admission in the program
- You must include an artist's statement to accompany the work (fewer than 500 words).
- Intermodal work is considered if made as one submission, but it must be accompanied by ONE artist statement of 500 or fewer words.
- You consent to have your work published online. If you wish to have your work removed from the website at any point in the future, you agree to notify the acting Community Counseling Program Coordinator by written request.
- Please ensure your submission is complete. A complete submission includes the titled artwork(s), one written artist's statement, and consent for publication (YOU MUST INCLUDE A STATEMENT in the body of the email that says you have read and you agree to the terms of this call for submissions. This serves as your consent for publication).

We will consider any work that can be captured by photograph or written word (i.e. sculpture, painting, drawing, collage, quilt, poetry, lyrics, written reflection of a movement experience, etc...). Please email image files and word documents to Wanda R. Ortiz at ortizwr@appstate.edu along with an artist's statement that accompanies the work. Video and music files may be accommodated on an individual basis, but please contact Wanda prior to submission to ensure the file types can be accommodated. These larger file types will need to be submitted in hard copy by disc or through Google Drive, and may have additional requirements.
