Studio workshops integrating clay, visual arts, movement, poetry, music, writing, ecotherapy, ritual, and performance invite artistic inquiry and renewal. As we inter-weave expressive arts theories with studio art-making throughout this course, we will examine possibilities for tending our inheritance by claiming our unique creative response/ability.

This intensive institute is offered both as a graduate course in the Department of Human Development & Psychological Counseling and as Continuing Education through the National Board of Certified Counselors (28 Continuing Education Clock Hours available). Students wishing to take the course for credit should register online. Non-credit students do not need to register separately through the university.
